

Before entering the school, i.e. already at home, it must be clarified that the students do not show any symptoms of COVID-19. If there are symptoms, medical clarification is paramount and the school is not to be entered.

Child suffers from sniffing, sneezing, and a runny nose;

Child stays at home for 24-hour observation

The doctor decides on the necessity of testing for COVID-19.

If the test result is
negative

Your child shows one or more of these symptoms:
Coughing, high temperature or fever, shortness of breath, loss of
smell / taste, symptoms indicating a cold including a runny nose
with a sore throat, headache and body aches, general weakness

The school needs to be informed!

If the test result is positive, your child must stay at home. Please
follow the instructions of the public health department in charge.
